# = Candidate was one of top two finishers in race requiring a “run-off” election but decided to withdraw candidacy prior to ballots for run-off election being mailed. Since no one candidate received a majority of the votes cast as required for this race, the next highest finisher will be a candidate in the run-off election.

In accordance with the Local Bylaws, elections for primary Local officers require the winning candidate to receive a majority of votes cast. Races in which no candidate receives a majority of the votes cast require a subsequent “run-off” election to be held between the two candidates who received the most votes in the initial election. In accordance with the CWA Constitution, “if no one nominee receives a majority on the first ballot and there is a tie for second place, a run-off election shall be conducted and the person receiving the greatest number of votes on the first ballot and the two persons who tied for second place shall be the nominees on the second ballot.” As indicated above, run-off elections are required for the positions of President, Secretary-Treasurer, Group Vice President I and Group Vice President II.

The above results were final certified by the Election Committee on January 24, 2012. Ballots for the run-off election will be mailed no later than Tuesday January 31, 2012. Ballots will be picked up at the Post Office at 11:30 am on Friday February 17, 2012 and counting of ballots will commence at 12:00 pm that day.
